

## **Battery change**

- If the lock produces 3 beeps after unlocking, the battery needs to be
- replaced.
- Pull the battery case up and replace the battery. Use a button cell CR2032 (not included).

\* The sound of the 3 beeps indicates that the battery will stay active for approximately 200 more uses.

#### Program a code

#### Lock

- Enter a 4-digit code and turn lock button to lock.
- Memorize this code.
- This code will be valid for one use only.

#### Unlock

Enter this 4 digit code again and turn lock button to unlock. Do NOT press OK.

\* If a mistake is made while entering the code, press OK to cancel and enter the code from the beginning.

\* If the code is entered incorrectly 4 times in a row, a 20 second continuous alarm will sound. Enter the correct code to silence the alarm.

#### Forgotten code

- Note the serial number located on the side of the lock.
- Contact Logiflex to obtain the master code for your lock.
- Enter the 8-digit master code and press OK.
- Turn the lock to open.

#### Forgotten code - with master key

- · Contact the person in charge of the master key.
- Insert the key and press OK.
- Turn the lock to open.
